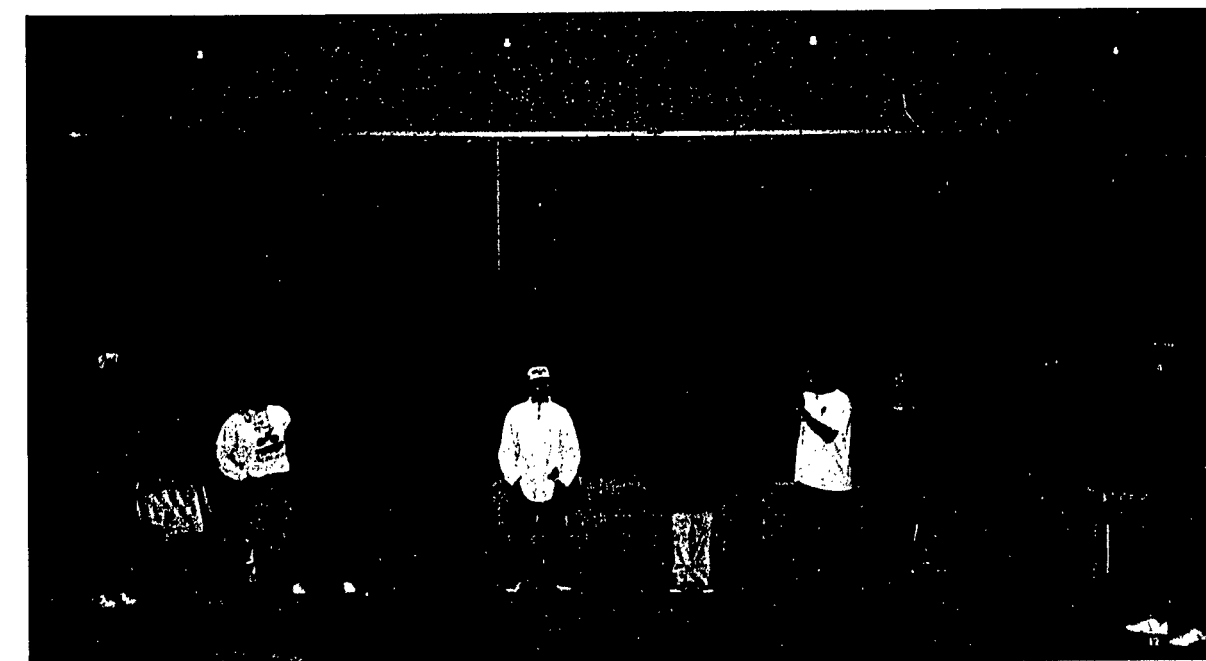
# THUNDERBIRD THEATRE

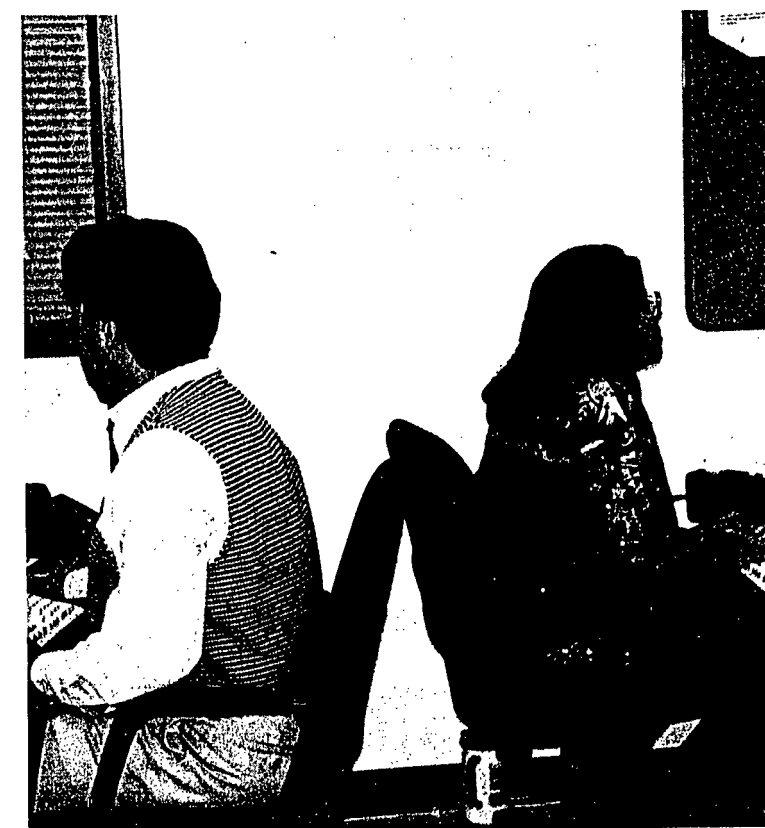

## Haskell and KU students protest the South Lawrence Trafficway on 31st street

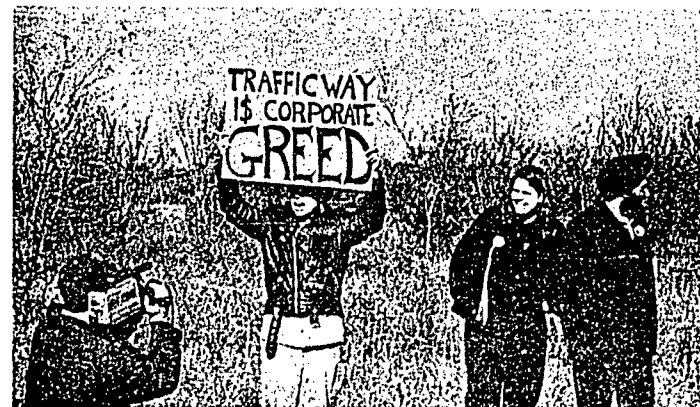
On Wednesday November 8, students from Haskell and KU stood along the sides of 31st street holding signs and tribal flags shouting and waving at drivers as they drove by.

There were many cameras and reporters who came from Kansas City and Topeka to get students' opinions about the wetlands. Some of the signs students held up read, "TRAFFICWAY IS CORPORATE GREED", "Destruction of the wetlands is pollution not progress", and "Indian land is not for sale".

The protest was held on the same day that the hearings on the South Lawrence Trafficway were being held at the Douglas County fairgrounds. The protest began about 2 p.m. with Richard Taliwood, a Haskell student, leading more than forty students from the medicine wheel to 31st street. The students stayed out in the cold for hours trying to get more support for Haskell.

As HINU student Maylynn Riding In commented, not all the drivers were pleased about the protest.

"Some of the drivers were giving us the finger and the thumbs down sign, that was really rude."

included pottery by Deloris Lewis Garcia, Emma Lewis Mitchell and Pam Lujan-Hauer; sandcast jewelry by Gary Custer; a pipe demonstration by Davis Jones and basketry by Squirrel and Larry Croslin.

The Art Market features many traditional and contemporary Native American handmade crafts and art work such as: Native American clothing and headdresses, beadwork, quillwork, drums, sculptures in wood, stone, and metal, pottery from traditional to contemporary, paintings, drawings, prints and jewelry of all types. Food concessions were sponsored by many of Haskell's student clubs and organizations.

Attendance for the Art Market has risen steadily every year. The attendance in 1992 was 12,000 with 95 participating artists, 1993 was 15,000 visitors with 114 participating artists and 1994 17,000 visitors with 155 artists. This year's Art Market featured 161 Native artists and an attendance of 25,000 visitors on Saturday and 25,000 visitors on Sunday according to Haskell Security.

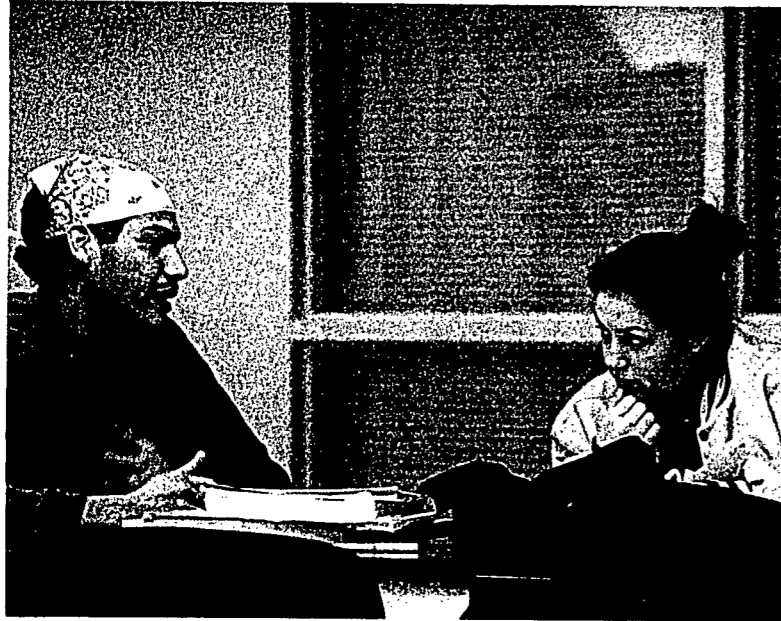

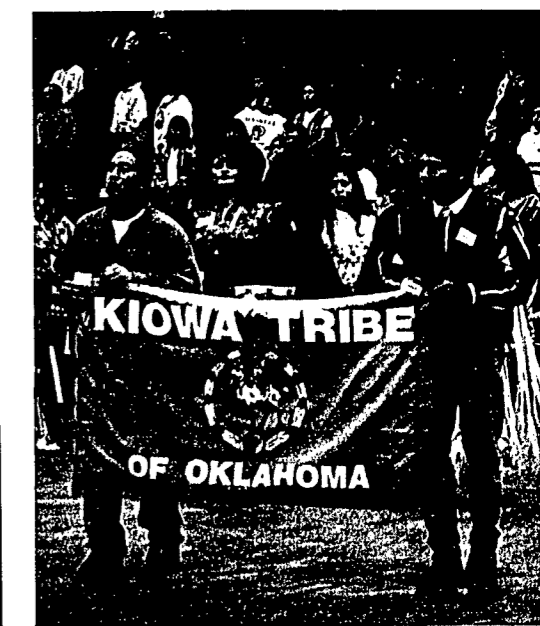

These were the words of comfort written in the memorial folder of Ernest "Ernie" Quimayousie. Ernie Quimayousie was born on December 28, 1955 he died from a short illness on August 20, 1995. He was 39 years old. Services were held at the Presbyterian Church in Ganado, Arizona on August 24, 1995.

Quimayousie was born into the Mountain People Clan of the Tohono O'odham Tribe and the Spider People Clan of the Hopi tribe. He was a member of the food service department here at Haskell and he was also a manager of the Haskell campus shope.

Georgia Keener, of the food service department, remembers Ernie back when he was a student here at Haskell. She said,

"he was a little ornery and he had an opinion about everything. When he worked here Ernie's interests were in the students, he did whatever he could to help them out. If they had a project in the dorm or a fund raiser, spirit fest or whatever, he was always willing to help." Georgia said,

"He would come in on his days off just to help them. In the cafeteria when you would see table clothes on the tables and balloons would be up, Ernie did that. He was just helpful all over the place. I sure do miss him, we all do."

Ernie was a good friend to many people not just students but to staff and faculty as well.

Ernest Quimayousie is survived by his parents Max and Katherine Quimayousie, his brothers David, Calvin, and Vernon Quimayousie, his sister, Rose Ann Pahona and by all those who knew and loved him.

Wesley associated at the Congressional level with United States Representatives and the United States President.

One of his biggest accomplishments and rewards came from President Ford who appointed him to a four year term on the National Advisory Council on Indian Education. Another reward was when he received an honorary doctorate degree from Haskell Indian Junior College. Based on Wesley's professional profile, he was selected and entered into the International Who's Who of Professionals.

Wesley dedicated his life to Indian Education. He touched the hearts of many and remains within the hearts of family and friends. We will miss Wesley dearly but Indian Education will continue.

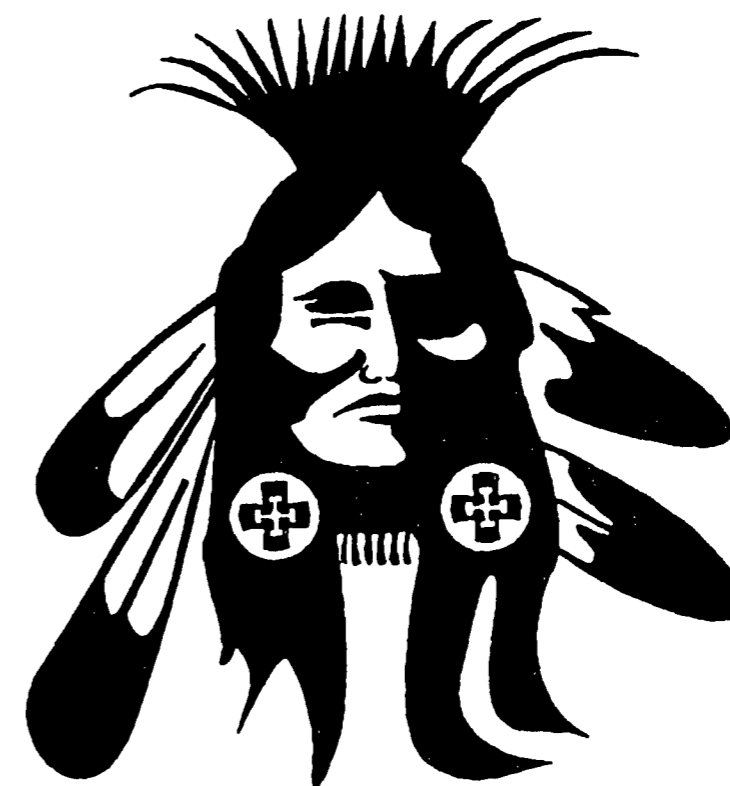

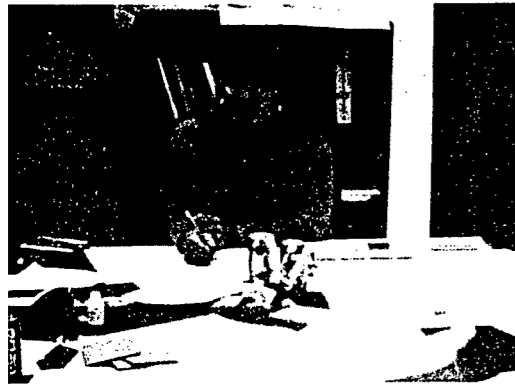
